

Proposed bylaw amendments

Requestor: Emily Smith, Austin Transportation Public Information Specialist and PAC staff liaison

Objective: Revise the PAC bylaws to remove the requirement for a "nominating subcommittee" to be formed annually at the August meeting/give a report at the September meeting + instead simply require that a committee be formed prior to the annual membership application close date and report their recommendations to the full membership prior to the annual elections meeting.
