Asian American Quality of Life Advisory Commission Meeting to be held September 18, 2020 with Social Distancing Modifications

Public comment will be allowed via telephone; no in-person input will be allowed. **All speakers must register in advance (September 17, 2020 by noon).** All public comment will occur at the beginning of the meeting.

To speak remotely at the **September 18, 2020 Asian American Quality of Life Advisory Commission Meeting**, residents must:

- Call or email the board liaison at **Joshua Robinson** at 512-974-9006 no later than noon, (September 17, 2020). The information required is the speaker name, item number(s) they wish to speak on, whether they are for/against/neutral, and a telephone number or email address.
- Once a request to speak has been called in or emailed to the board liaison, residents will receive either an email or phone call providing the telephone number to call on the day of the scheduled meeting.
- Speakers must call in at least 15 minutes prior to meeting start in order to speak, late callers will not be accepted and will not be able to speak.
- Speakers will be placed in a queue until their time to speak.
