

RAILROAD CROSSING ASSESSMENT UPDATE (RESOLUTION 20190919-083) **BICYCLE ADVISORY COUNCIL SEPTEMBER 15, 2020**

BACKGROUND

- City Council Resolution 20190919-083 directed the City Manager to review railroad crossings citywide, including seven (7) priority locations identified by community advocates, for opportunities to improve the safety for people crossing the tracks on bicycles or scooters, people on foot and people using assistive mobility devices.
- Memo to Mayor and Council with an initial <u>Assessment Report</u> was published January 2020 with findings for the top 7 locations.

CITYWIDE ANALYSIS

- Citywide analysis completed.
- Majority of crossings are within acceptable angle tolerances.
- ATD and PWD are currently engaged in the Mobility Annual Planning (MAP) process to prioritize work for 2021 and beyond.
- The 2021 MAP coordination process will look at crossing improvements where we have existing capital work and crossings with less than 45-degree angles where there is a feasible opportunity for improvement.
