SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with PEPPER-LAWSON CONSTRUCTION, L.P., Houston, TX for the construction of the Northeast Interim Wastewater Treatment Plant in the amount of \$5,319,000 plus a \$250,000 contingency, for a total authorized amount not to exceed \$5,569,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$5,569,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Lowest bid of five received.

MBE / WBE: 23.19 % MBE and 3.93 % WBE subcontractor participation.

This construction contract will provide for the Phase I construction of a 0.75 million gallon per day (MGD) advanced wastewater treatment plant on the Wild Horse Ranch development site. This wastewater treatment plant will serve wastewater customers in the northeast Austin area including Wild Horse Ranch, the City of Manor, and Applied Materials and is the first phase in providing regional wastewater service to the Northeast area. Additionally, the construction of this wastewater treatment plant is in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement executed September 30, 2002 between the City of Austin and the City of Manor.

Specifically included in the construction contract are the following items: access road improvements, approximately 640 ft. of raw wastewater influent line, an influent lift station equipped with submersible pumps, screening and grit removal units, aeration basins, a final clarifier, scum collection facilities, return activated sludge pump system, effluent filtration, ultraviolet disinfection system, chemical addition facilities for phosphorus removal, sludge collection units, effluent discharge pipe, an operations building, electrical switchgear/MCC's and related electrical equipment, electrical duct banks, storm water detention and water quality ponds,, plant roads and sidewalks, site grading and drainage, and other site work.



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Bids were opened December 11, 2003. Bids were distributed to 11 General Contractors. Five (5) bids were received:

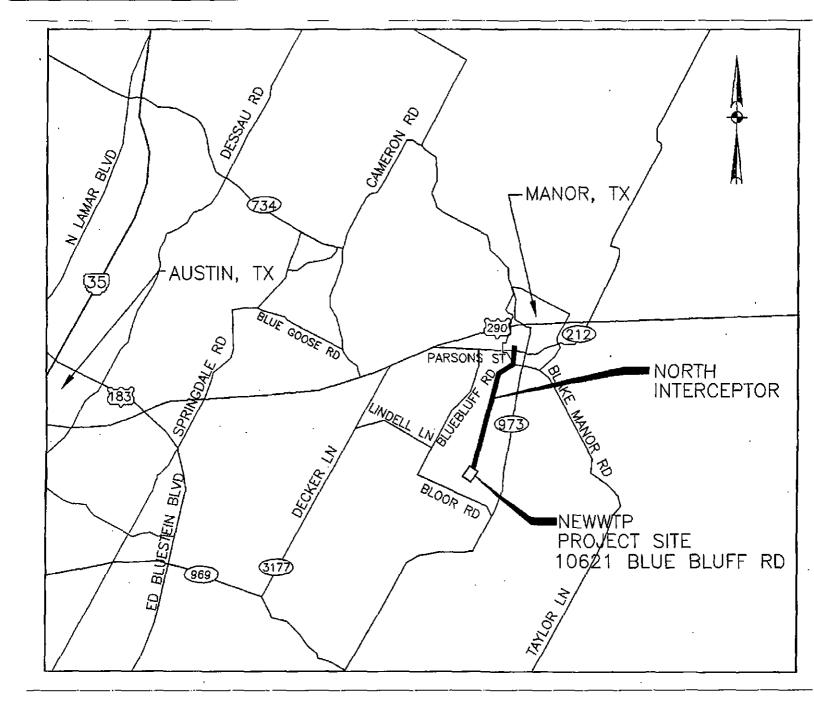
