The City of Austin's existing Community Scorecard has the potential to become a benchmark document for reporting annual performance information. In order to further the potential of the Community Scorecard, the City has submitted the 2002 report for review and feedback of Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) criteria in the Service Efforts and Accomplishments (SEA) pilot project. Based on the SEA feedback, revisions will be made to the 2003 report. With the help of the Government Performance Reporting Demonstration Grant project, the City will solicit feedback from the City of Austin community on its 2003 report to further make revisions to its 2004 and 2005 reports. Citizens will be requested to provide feedback on specific measures, data calculations, and document appearance. Grant funding will be used to cover Citizen survey and document improvement costs.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FY 2003-2004 FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 030909-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$30,000 in grant funds from the National Center for Civic Innovation in conjunction with the Sloan Foundation.
- **PART 2.** The Council amends the FY 2003-2004 Financial and Administrative Services Department Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 030909-01 to appropriate \$30,000 to the Special Revenue Fund for the government performance reporting demonstration project.
- PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
