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SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with JORDAN-WHITFIELD, INC., Austin, TX, for the Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Metals Digestion Laboratory Renovations in an amount not to exceed \$181,600.

The Metals Digestion Laboratory located at the Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant supports the Environmental Analytical Services instrument laboratory by providing space and equipment for the digestion and preparation of process and environmental samples prior to analysis for metals. The laboratory also serves as an area where all of the Environmental Analytical Services labware is prepared and cleaned. The Austin Water Utility laboratory staff determined the need for renovation of the space due to changes in laboratory customer demands and the need to replace equipment due to deterioration and changes in testing requirements. The renovation will allow the laboratory to maintain necessary instrumentation and meet regulatory analytical requirements now and in the future.

The Metals Digestion Laboratory, once renovated, will have new walls and finishes; frames; casework; and will include new laboratory equipment, updated electrical, HVAC, and plumbing systems. The contract allows 120 working days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 5 general contractors. Bids were opened on December 11, 2003. Jordan-Whitfield, Inc. submitted the lowest of 4 bids received:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for 10 areas of subcontracting opportunities: aluminum storefront and glazing; plumbing; roofing, doors and frames, ceramic tile; acoustical ceilings and drywall; electrical, HVAC; resilient flooring and base; and laboratory equipment.


