1 Run dryers, dishwashers and other large appliances after dark so your air conditioner isn't fighting too many battles at once.

3 Check all of your vents to make sure they're open, free of dust and directing air toward the center of the room.

4 Replace your shower head with a low-flow model. Doing so reduces both your water and energy use from your water heater.
- 

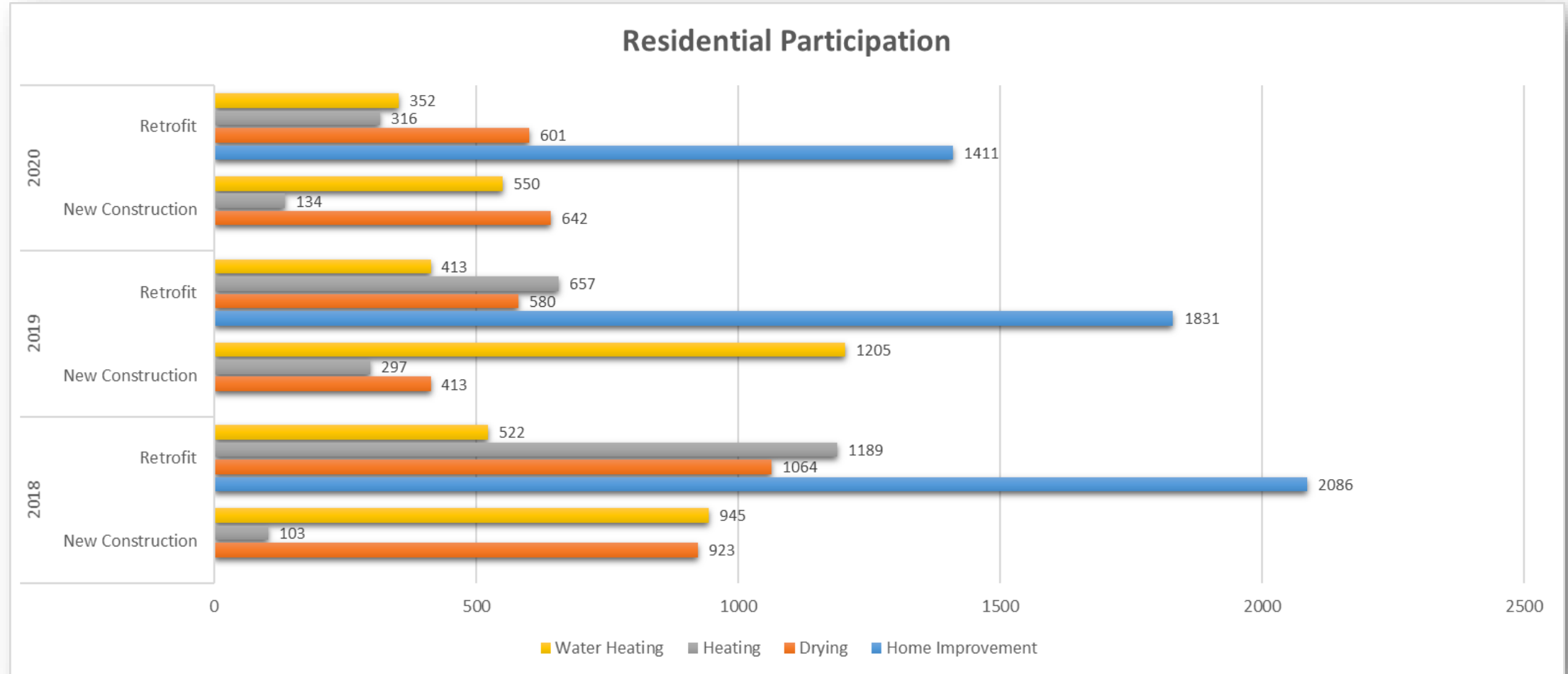
5 Upgrade to high-efficiency natural gas appliances to save time, energy and money!

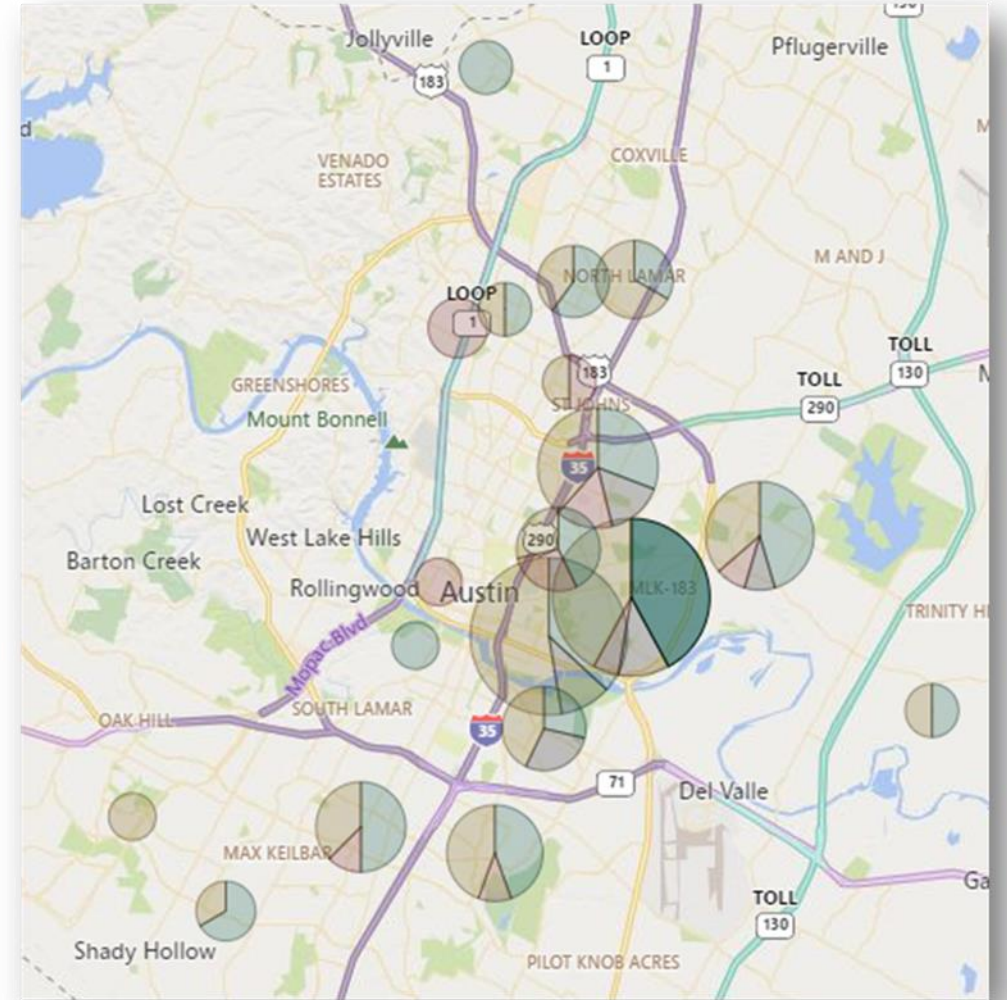

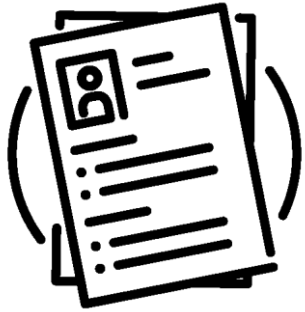
