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SUBJECT: Authorize negotiation and execution of change order # 10 to the construction contract with Construction Manager at Risk, HENSEL PHELPS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, Austin, TX, for repair and repaving of Cesar Chavez Street, and the installation of parking garage control equipment in the New City Hall - Building and Public Plaza (Phase III) in the amount of \$345,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$33,242,000.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING:</u> Funding in the amount of \$180,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Economic Growth and Redevelopment Services Office; \$165,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Public Works Department.

On December 12, 2002, City Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Construction Manager-at-Risk (CMR) contract with Hensel Phelps Construction Company for a Construction Manager Fee, General Conditions, an estimated allowance for Pre-Construction Phase Services and an estimated allowance for an Initial Construction Trade Package, for an early start of construction on the New City Hall and Public Plaza (Phase III), in an amount not to exceed \$16,968,282. The CMR contract was executed January 3, 2003, with Amendments #1A and #1B executed on April 7, 2003 and May 16, 2003, respectively, for the fees described above and Initial Construction Trade Packages. On July 17, 2003, City Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate and execute Amendment #2 to the CMR contract for the remaining construction trade packages, with an increase to the contract authorization in the amount of \$15,883,718, for a total contract authorization of \$32,852,000. On December 4, 2003, this authorization was increased by \$45,000, using administrative authority, to provide additional Owner's contingency for pending change order work; for a total contract authorization of \$32,897,000.



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Approval of this change order will accomplish two things: 1) correct minor drainage irregularities along Cesar Chavez Street from, and including, the San Antonio Street intersection to, and including, the Colorado Street intersection and will provide a new curb to curb road surface to match the new road surfaces on Lavaca, Guadalupe and Second Streets, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000; and 2) allow the installation of parking control equipment in the underground parking garage, including ticket dispensers, entrance and exit gates, card readers and a parking attendant booth, in an amount not to exceed \$180,000. Funding for the parking control equipment is being provided by funds made available through a reimbursement from AMLI Austin Retail as part of the City's agreement with AMLI for the development of Second Street retail project, which is also scheduled for action.

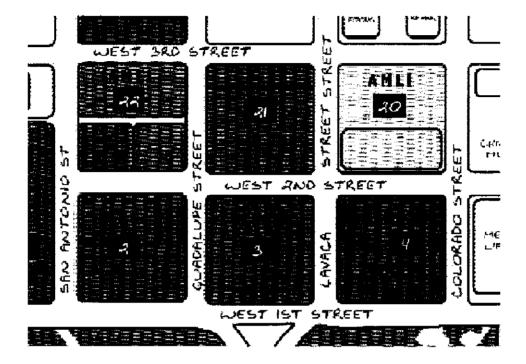
