- 11. Collaborate with the Austin Travis County Food Policy Board to promote climate-friendly diets and reduce food waste
- 12. Make equity a priority in all of these initiatives
- 13. Advise on the possible expansion of the Joint Sustainability Committee to be more diverse and inclusive
