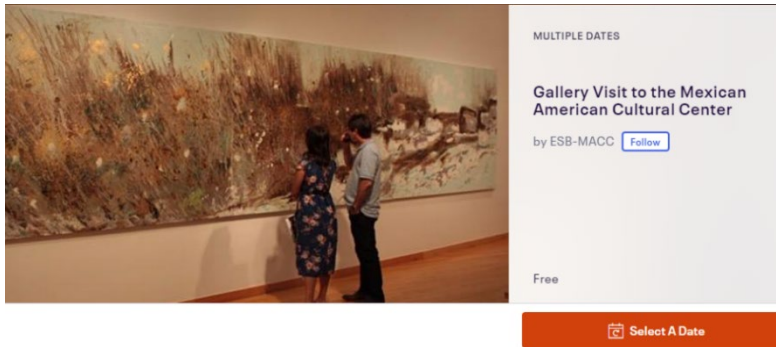

Stay Creative! Digital Summer Program (June/July)

- Online program hours are 9am-5pm Mon-Thurs. Program dates are July 6-30.
- Instruction/ Collaboration with AARC, Carver, DAC, Austin Nature & Science Center
- Lottery system to register participants. 803 registrations were received for 500+ spots.
- Entire program is FREE, with free supply kits available for parents to pick up (curbside, no contact).



Latino Artist Access Program

- LAAP Reservations began June 15th (Ballet Folklorico, etc) but had to be cancelled as of June 29th.
- Resources sent to LAAP artists: Metro Music Project, COA Grants, Artist Emergency Relief Fund
- Two LAAP artist have participated in Desde La Sala Concert Series: Mauricio Callejas, Monique Dache, Javier Jara
- [LAAP webpage](#) created to promote artists online, featured in the MACC Newsletter on May 15
- Several LAAP events scheduled for 2020 have been moved to virtual events or rescheduled to 2021.
- The Spring LAAP Meet & Greet will now be done virtually.
- On May 7th we invited the LAAP artists to use MACC spaces for virtual filming. A few expressed interest; one made a reservation (PT). PT cancelled the reservation with less than 48 hours notice .



Caminos Teen Program

- 2019 Class graduated in March, 2020 Class started in April
- 11 new Caminos students have been in training and orientation online throughout May.
- The students meet online Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
- Students post their projects on Instagram: @atxcaminos
- Photo ATX Youth Photography Exhibit Online in August 2020
- Caminos Talkshow focusing on issues affecting Austin area teens. includes a digital Art Club; an interview segment highlighting Latino Entrepreneurship and a mini-telenovela focusing on teen issues. First episode airs July 24th. Will be a series of 10 episodes.
- Caminos Arts Exhibit at the Austin Central Library in mid-September showcasing the MACC
- Mosaic Mural Wall celebrating Latina heroes installation is moving forward, to be unveiled Spring 2021
