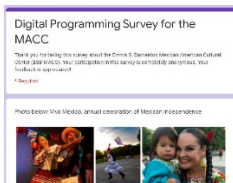
Events

witnessed and an artist will interpret that kind act through their art.

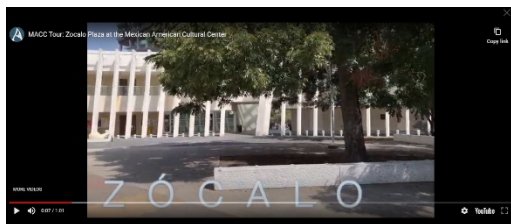
