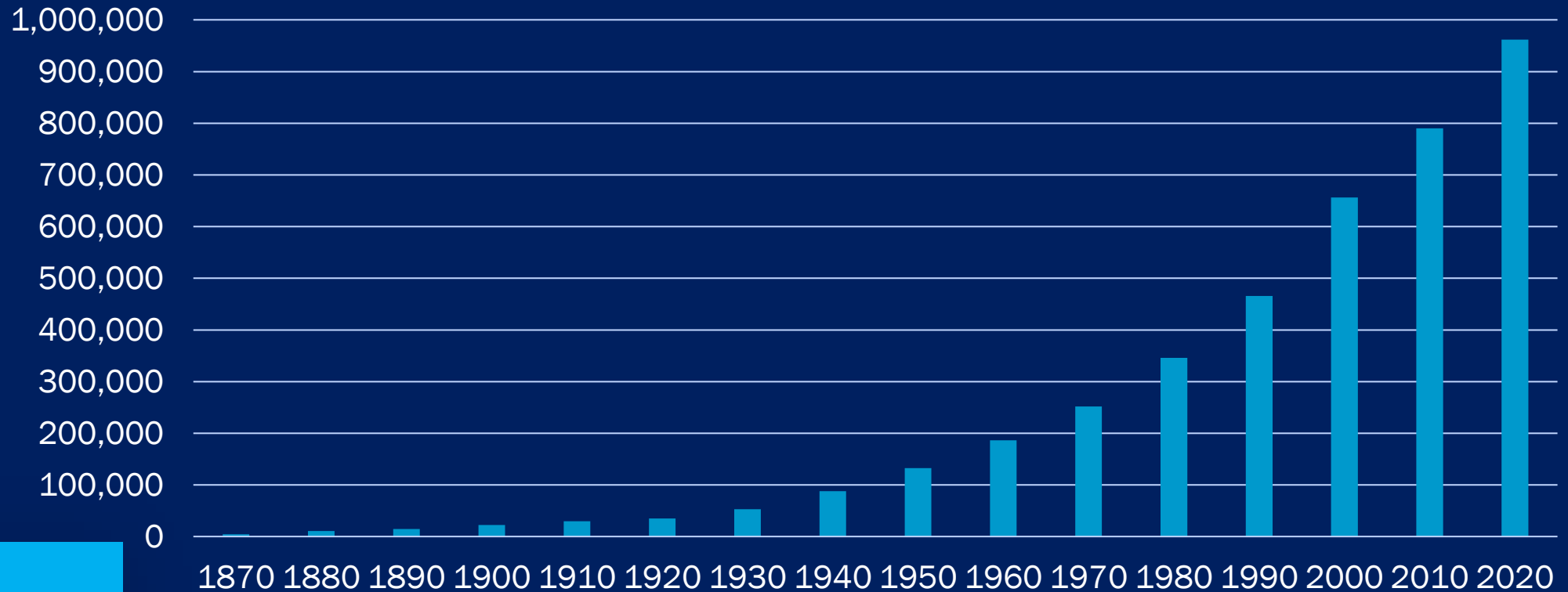


Austin's Population Growth



Austin Population Growth, 1870 to 2020

The ideal city council district size would be approximately 96,186.



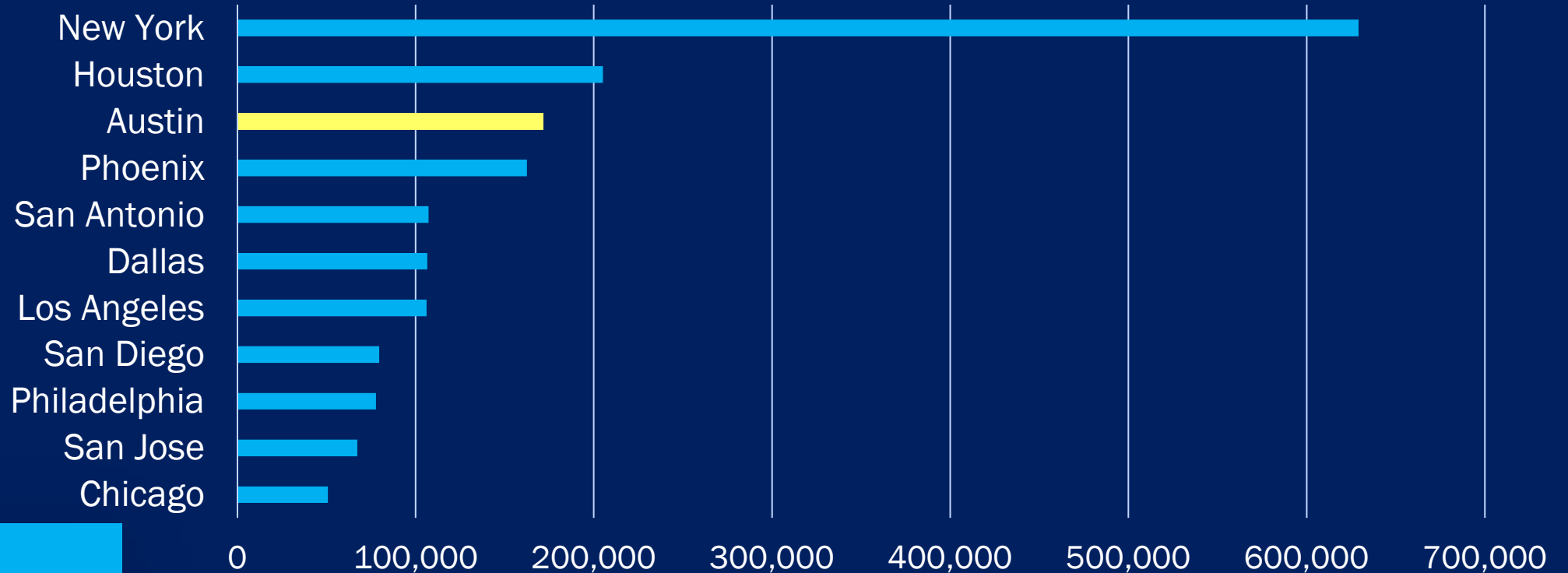

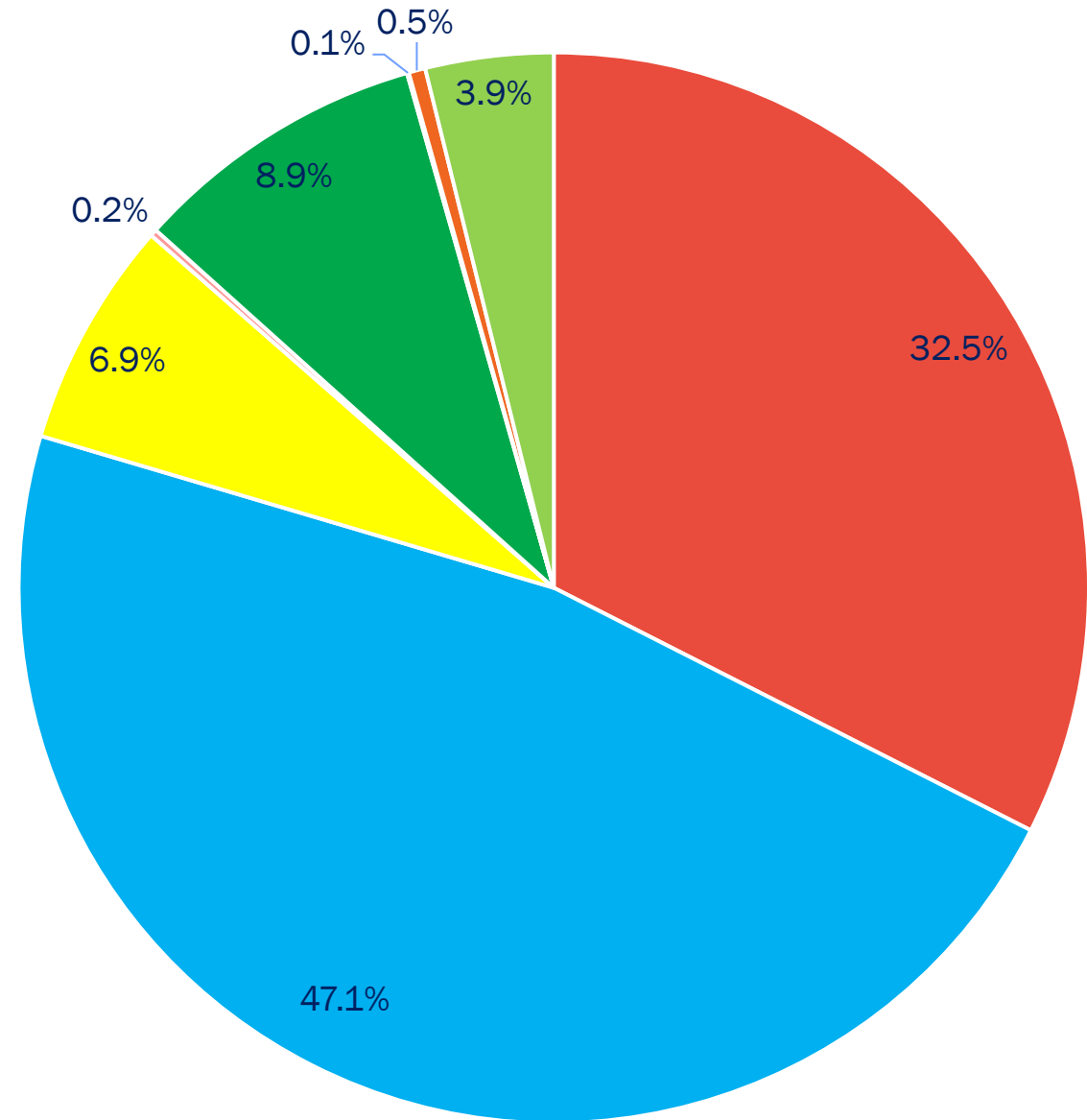

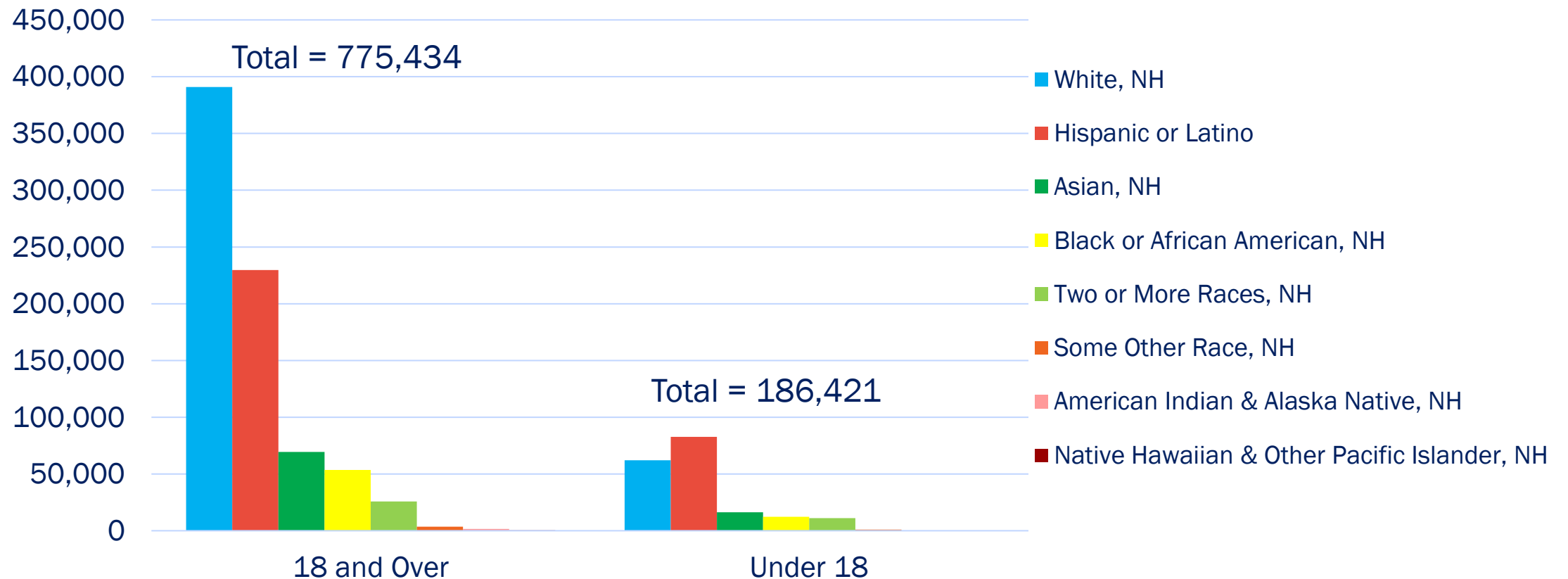

Over and Under 18 by Race/Ethnicity



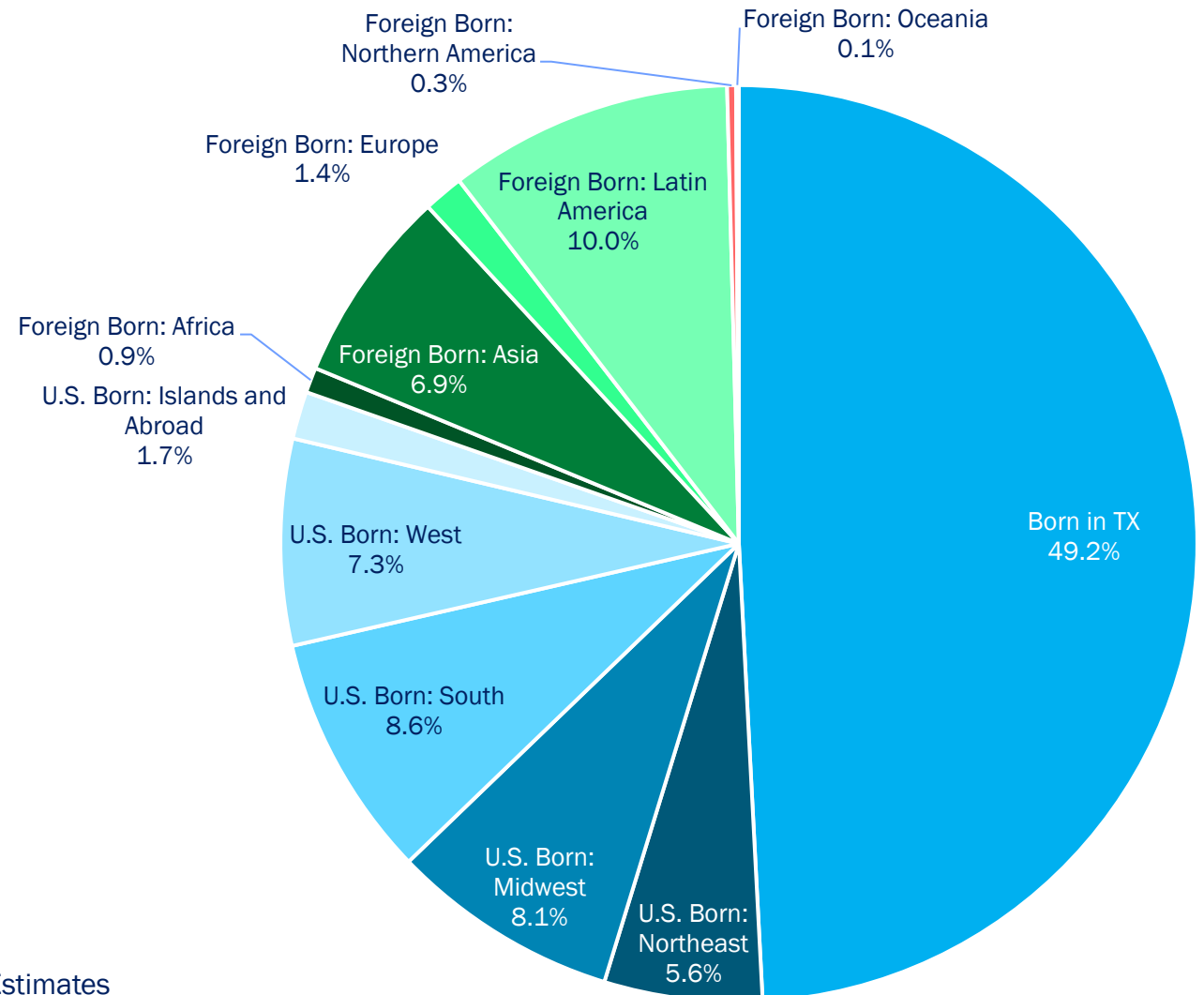

Where are Austinites from?

- Share of Austin residents born in Texas has dropped from 55% to 49% in last decade.
- Share of Austin residents from other countries has remained stable at 18%.
- Biggest increase seen among Austin residents from other U.S. states, growing from 26% to 31% in last decade.

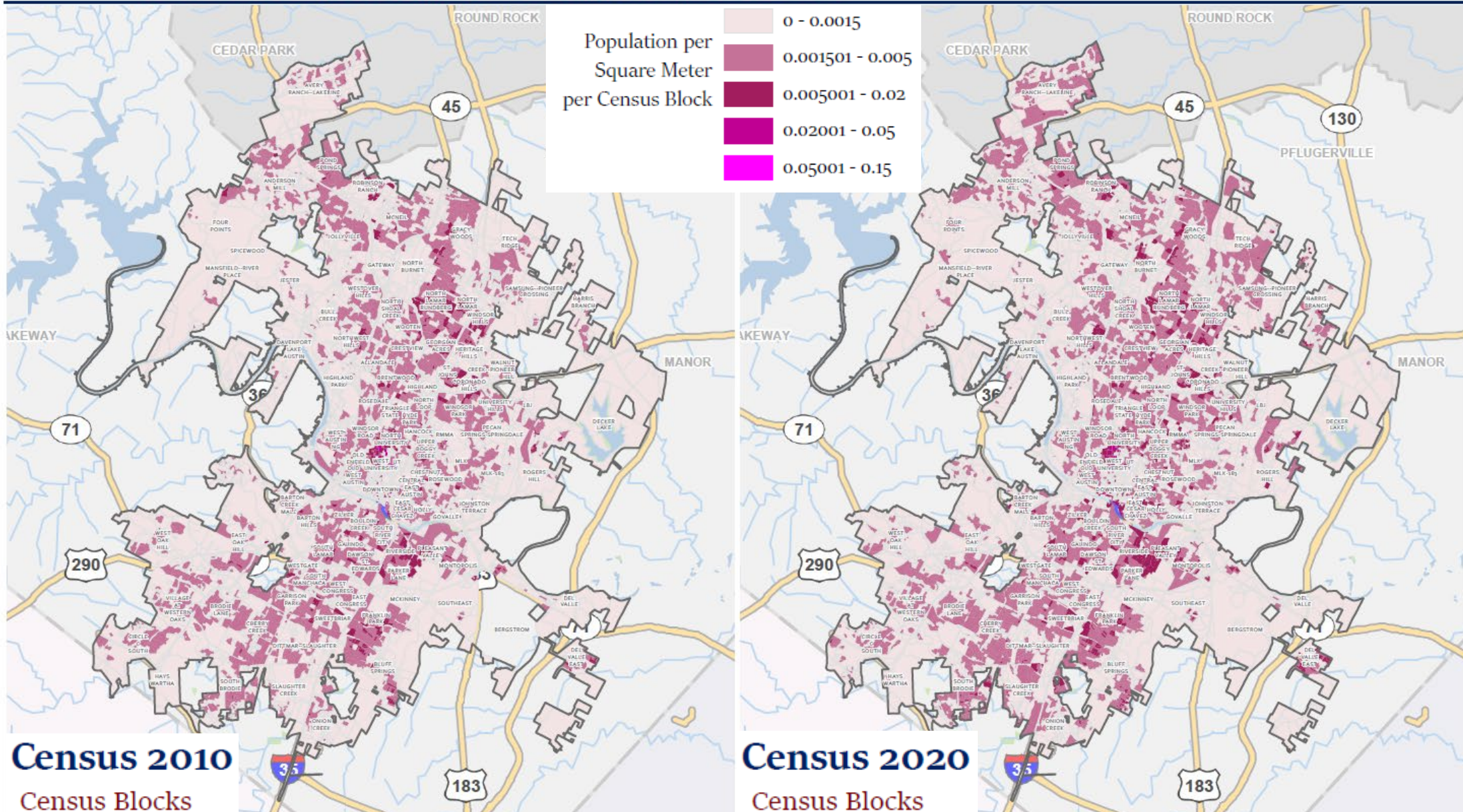

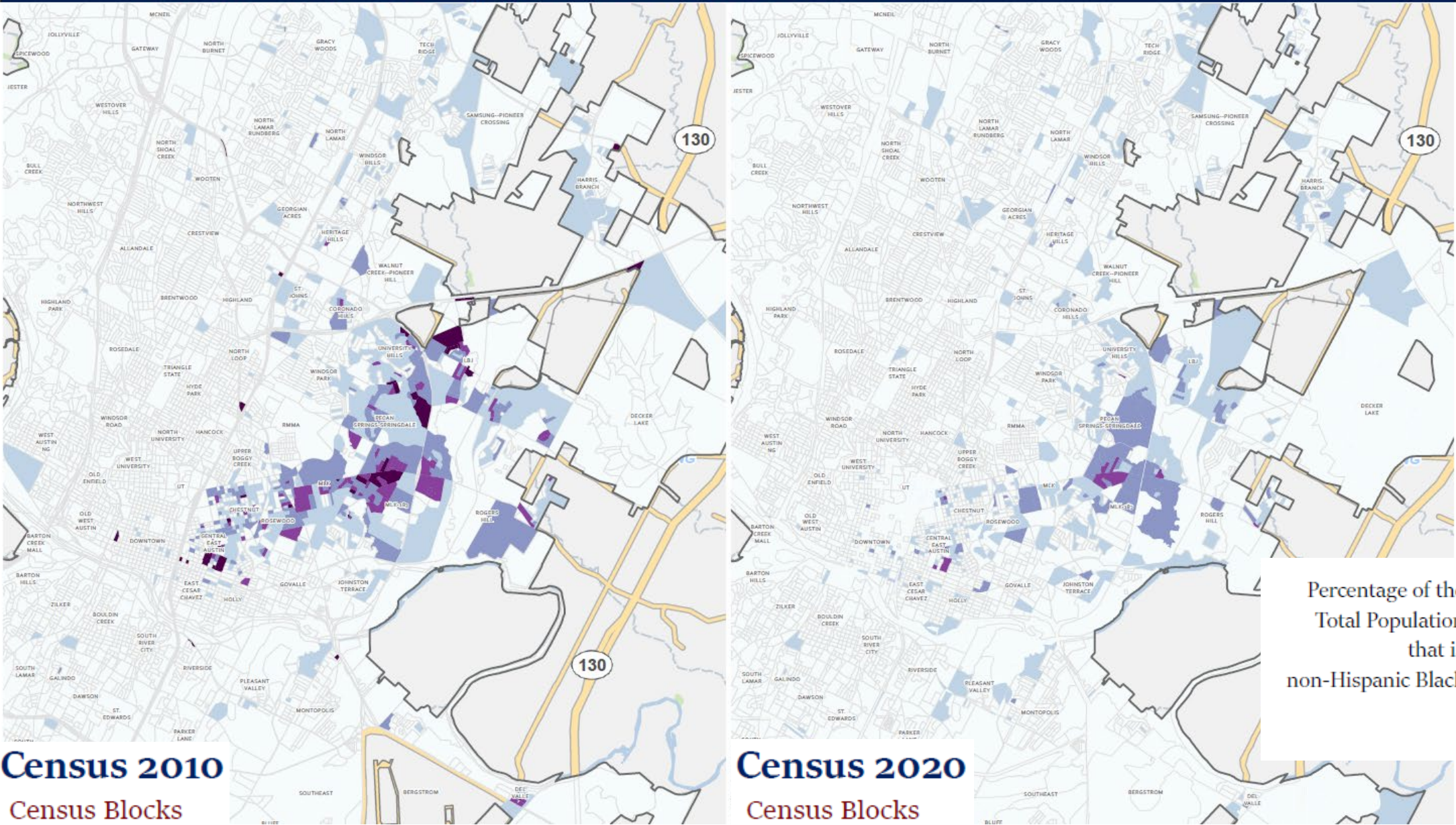

Black (non-Hispanic) Geographic Distribution, 2010-2020



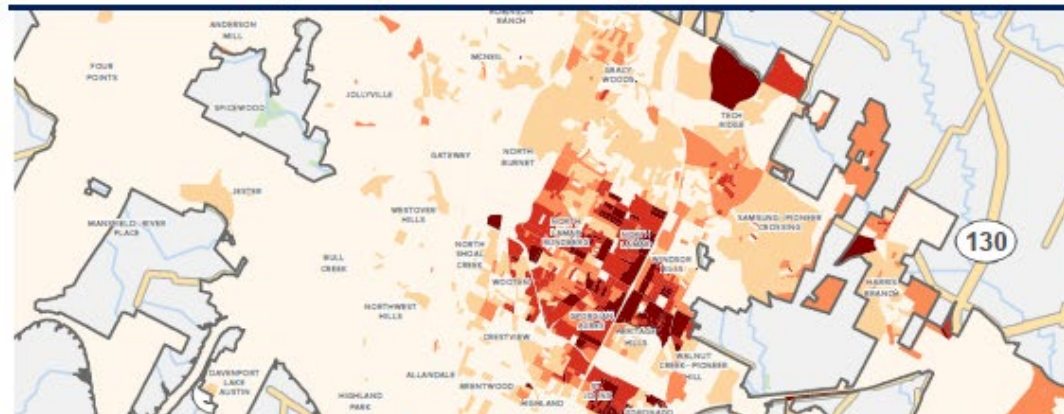

Hispanic/Latino Geographic Distribution, 2010-2020

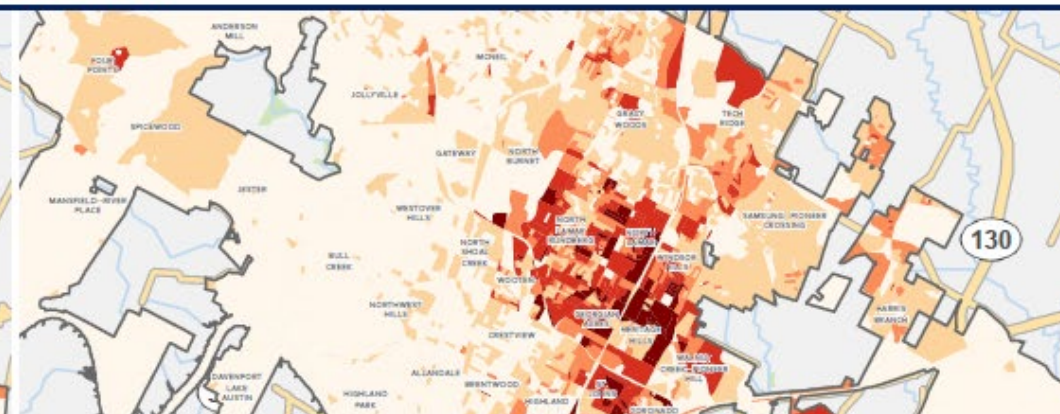
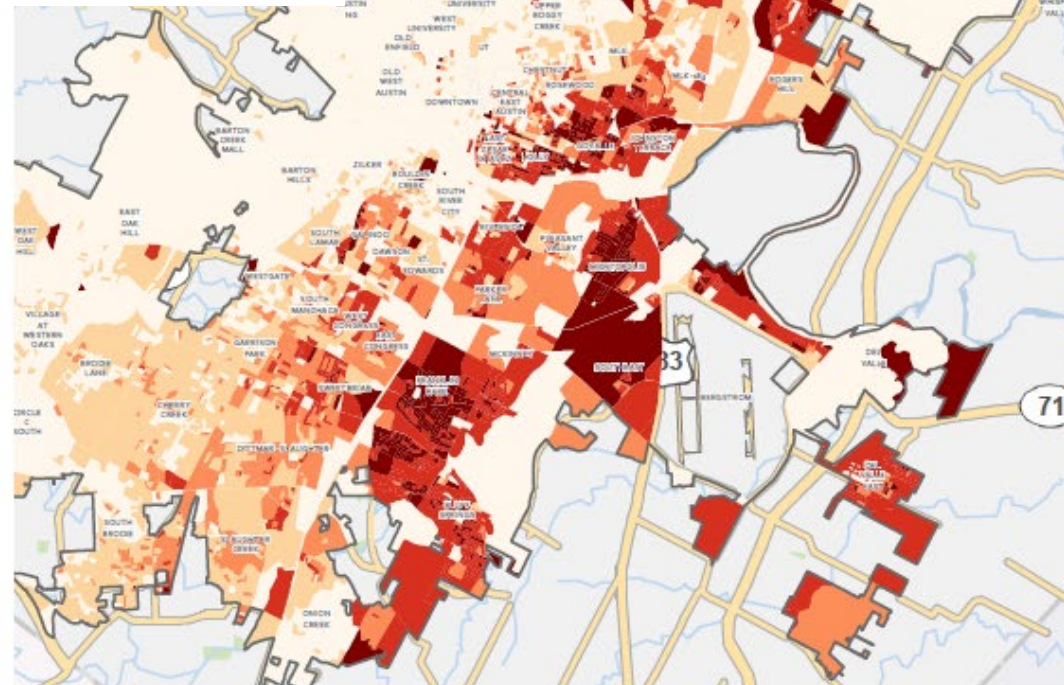


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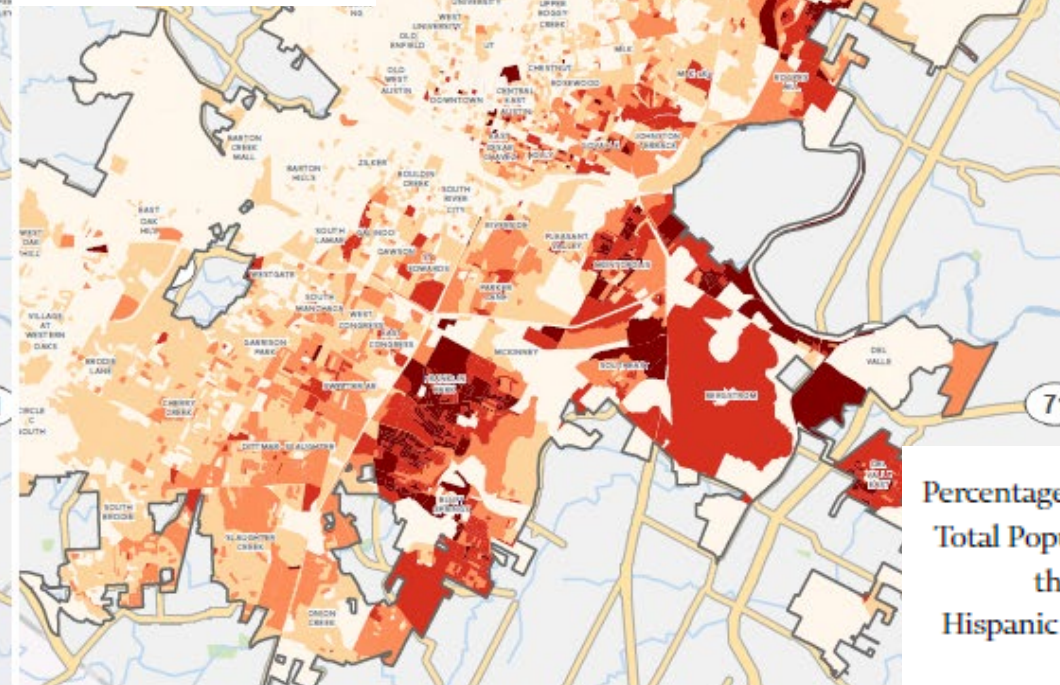

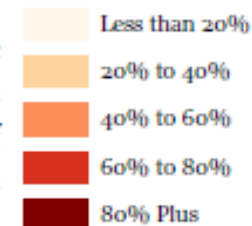

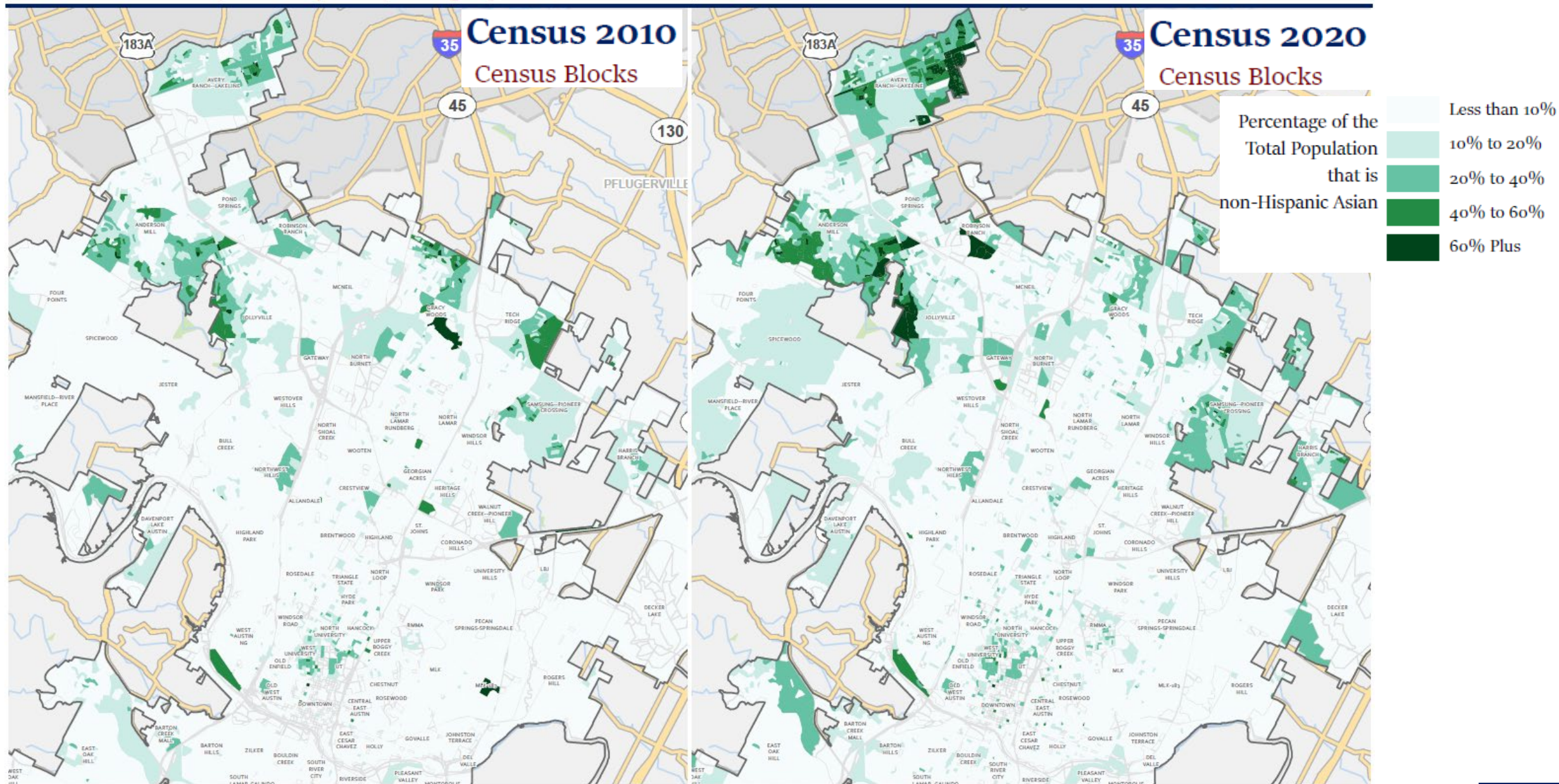

Asian (non-Hispanic) Geographic Distribution, 2010-2020



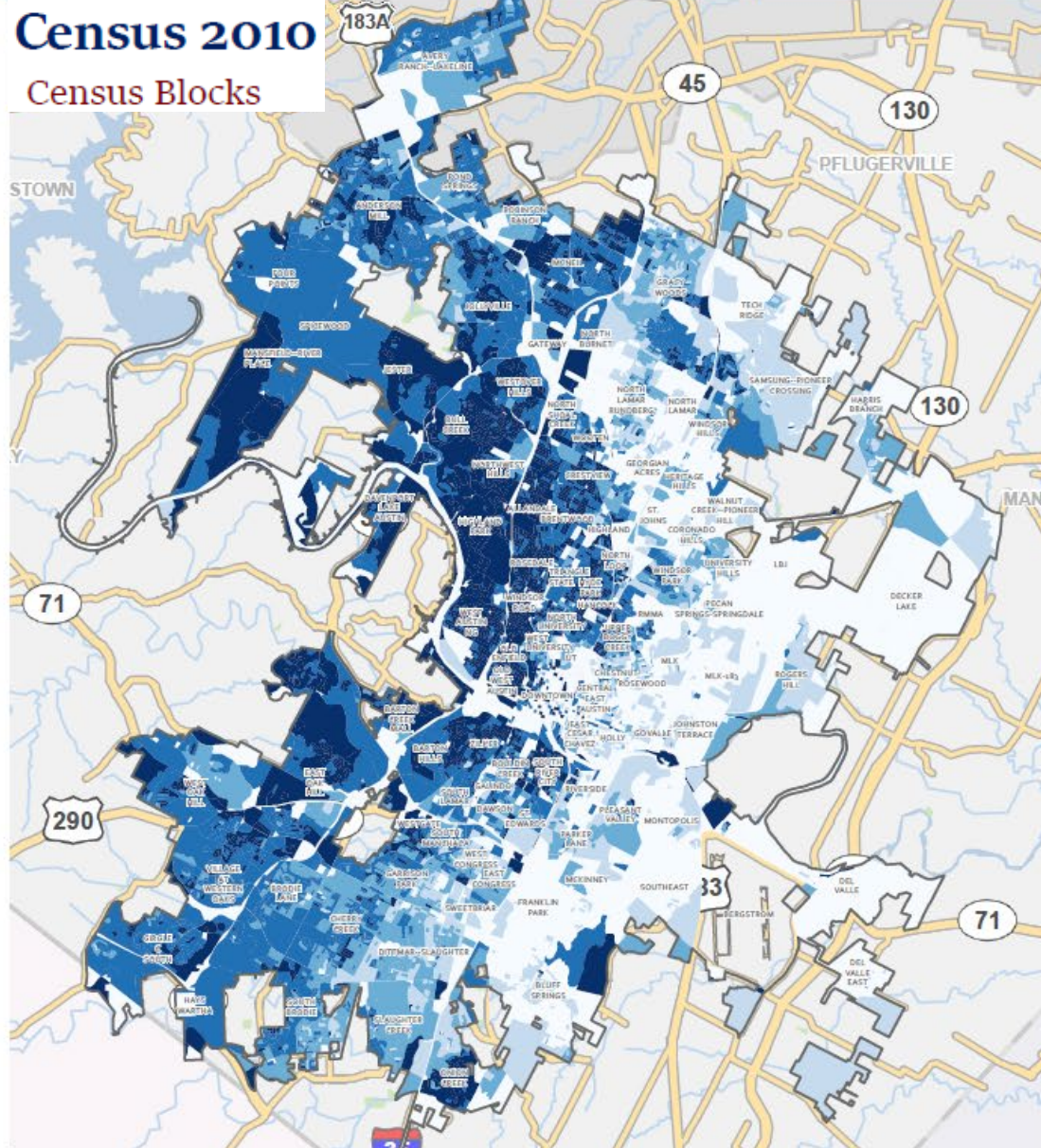

White (non-Hispanic) Geographic Distribution, 2010-2020

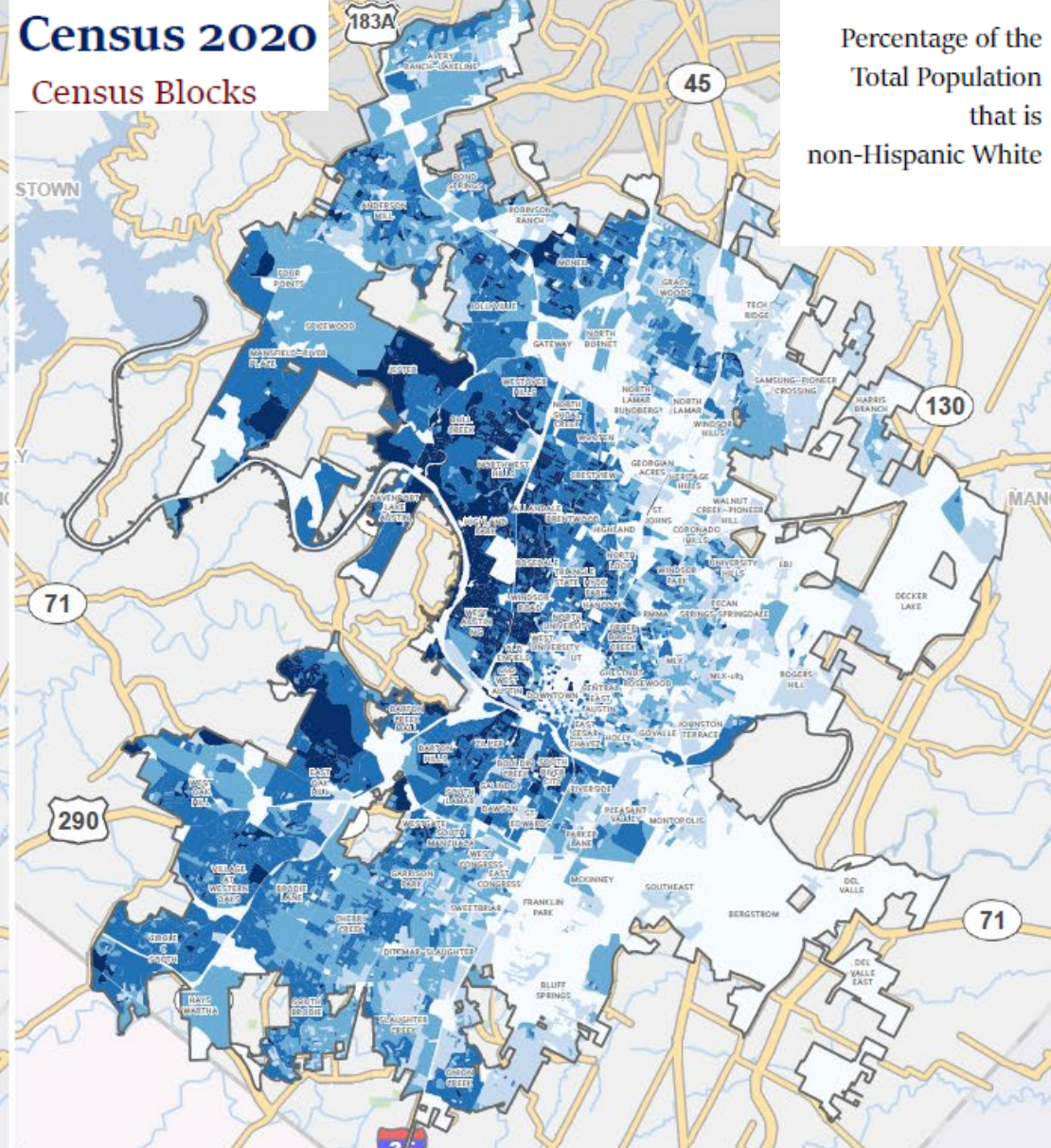


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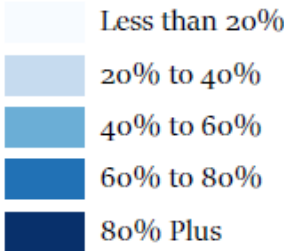
Census 2010 Census Blocks
