# Registration / Certification

- **REGISTRATION** allows a facility to upload its information
- Not Audited, only self-reported
- CERTIFICATION includes audited/verification and evaluation of data and operational processes

- FULL / CONDITIONAL
- SINGLE or MIXED MATERIAL
- MSW and MIXED MATERIAL COMBINED
- Application Process....

- Application for Certification Narrative, Spreadsheets, Data files
- Reporting Monthly, Warning Notices, Public Access

# Certification / Re-Cert Cycle

- Certification for 5-years
- Initial Certification Year 1
- Recertification Years 2 5
- New Certification Year 6

Registrations	\$400
Certification Mixed (CDRA member)	\$7,000
Certification Mixed (non-member)	\$8,000
Certification – Single (CDRA member)	\$2,500
Certification – Single (non-member)	\$3,500
Re-Certification – Mixed	\$3,500

# Standard Rate Calculation

Facility Incoming Tons	950
------------------------	-----

- Recovered Commodities (A) 600
  - Alternate Daily Cover (B) 250
    - Trash (C) 150
- Total Tons across the Line (D) 1000

Recovery Rate with ADC = (A + B) / D

600 + 250 / 1000 = 85.0%

Recovery Rate without ADC = A / D

600 / 1000 = 60.0%
