

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 **AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE PRESIDING JUDGE, ASSOCIATE**
2 **JUDGES INCLUDING THE DOWNTOWN AUSTIN COMMUNITY COURT**
3 **JUDGE, AND SUBSTITUTE JUDGES OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN MUNICIPAL**
4 **COURT; AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS.**

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6 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**
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8 **PART 1.** The City Council appoints Evelyn McKee as the Presiding Judge of the
9 Municipal Court for the term beginning January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2005.

10 **PART 2.** The City Council appoints the following people as Associate Judges of the
11 Municipal Court for the term beginning January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2005:

16 **PART 3.** The City Council appoints Associate Judge Michael Coffey to serve as the
17 judge of the Downtown Austin Community Court.

18 **PART 4.** The City Council appoints the following people as Substitute Judges for the
19 Municipal Court for the for the term beginning January 1, 2004, and ending December
20 31, 2005:

1 **PART 5.** The City Council does not appoint to the Municipal Court the term beginning
2 January 1, 2004, and ending December 31, 2005, any person not specifically named in
3 this ordinance.

4 **PART 6.** Compensation for the Presiding Judge is \$3,520.80 per pay period.

5 **PART 7.** Compensation for an Associate Judge, including the Downtown Austin
6 Community Court Judge, is \$2,849.60 per pay period.

7 **PART 8.** Compensation for a Substitute Judge is \$35.62 per hour.

8 **PART 9.** The Presiding Judge and Associate Judges, including the Downtown Austin
9 Community Court Judge, shall receive the following benefits:

- 10 (A) participation in the Employees' Retirement System;
- 11 (B) a choice of medical and dental plans currently offered to classified City
12 employees, with a City subsidy equivalent to that provided to City employees;
- 13 (C) \$20,000.00 in group term life insurance;
- 14 (D) additional group term life insurance available for purchase;
- 15 (E) long term disability insurance available for purchase;
- 16 (F) eight hours sick leave accrual per month;
- 17 (G) eight hours vacation leave accrual per month;
- 18 (H) paid holidays as designated by the City Council; and
- 19 (I) if eligible, service incentive pay in the same amount and under the same
20 conditions as non-Civil Service employees.

21 **PART 10.** A substitute judge shall serve only as scheduled by the presiding judge, and is
22 not eligible for City benefits or compensation except as provided for in Part 8. Part 9
23 does not apply to a substitute judge.

24 **PART 11.** The terms "sick leave," "vacation," and "holidays" have the same meaning
25 given to them in the City of Austin Personnel Policies for Non-Civil Service Employees.
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1 **PART 12.** This ordinance takes effect on March 1, 2004.
