The Labor Contract Bargaining Process

Background

- 1. State law authorizes labor contracts with public safety employee associations
- 2. Two types of labor contract bargaining:
 - Meet and confer sworn Police and EMS employees
 - Collective bargaining sworn Fire employees
 - City's bargaining process historically the same for both types
- 3. Current labor contracts all expire on 09/30/2022
 - **APD:** agreement extends automatically to 03/31/23
 - **AFD and EMS:** parties can extend past 09/30/22 by agreement in 30-day increments if actively negotiating (max. extension = 6 months)



The Bargaining Process

- Request for bargaining notice given by Association ~ 9-12 mos. before current agreement expires
- 2. Preparation for bargaining parties review issues arising during current contract and evaluate wage/benefit issues for next contract
- **3.** Bargaining sessions negotiating teams conduct contract negotiations in public sessions
- Tentative agreement if negotiating teams reach agreement on all topics:
 - Tentative agreement must be approved by Association and City Council
 - Agreement becomes effective upon approval by both
