At the request of the Historic Landmark Commission, I am contacting you to discuss the demolition by neglect of the remains of the Sebron Sneed Mansion at 1801 Nelms Drive, which is owned by you.

The Sebron Sneed Mansion is a city historic landmark. We are very concerned about the condition of this structure, which is in serious need of attention to prevent its continued deterioration. We are very gratified to see the new fencing and clean-up of the site, but we need to discuss a stabilization plan for the ruins to prevent their collapse.
