November 26, 1958 10:00 A.M.

The Director of Public Works stated that the walks around the Auditorium would be finished up this afternoon or Friday; that as soon as the equipment was moved, that grass would be planted on the north and west sides by the end of next week. The City Manager reported that the representatives from the Shrine Circus had made a tour of the Auditorium and had said the Auditorium would make the finest place to present the circus in the state.
