



Austin City Council MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
NOVEMBER 12, 1997 - 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Watson called the meeting to order, noting the absence of Mayor Pro Tem Garcia and Councilmembers Goodman and Griffith.

Public hearing on the annexation of U.S. 183 East, Case No. C7a-97-004, which includes Springwoods Municipal Utility District, and other areas generally located between North Austin Municipal Utility District on the east, McNeil Road on the south, U.S. Highway 183 on the west, and Pond Springs Road, Anderson Mill Road, and North Austin MUD on the north, all of which are in Williamson and Travis County, Texas.

Luther Polnau, City of Austin Manager of Information and Planning, gave a brief overview.

Several department directors and assistant directors presented the different areas of the service plan.

Assistant City Manager Toby Futrell presented areas of information on the annexation issues and where these could be located.
