

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MAY 9, 2000

The following represents the actions taken by the Austin City Council in the order they occurred during the meeting.

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called Meeting on Tuesday, May 9, 2000 in the City Manager's Conference Room, Room 304 located at 124 West 8th Street.

Mayor Watson called the meeting to order at 11:08 a.m.

- 1. To canvass results of the City Council General Municipal Election of May 6, 2000.

 Resolution No. 000509-01 was approved on Council Member Griffith's motion,

 Council Member Slusher's second by a 6-0 vote. Council Member Lewis was absent.
- 2. Approve an Ordinance calling a Runoff Election to be held in the City of Austin to elect Council Members on June 3, 2000 for City Council for a term of three years beginning on June 15, 2000, making provisions for the conduct of the election; and declaring an emergency.
 - Ordinance No. 000509-02 was approved on Council Member Griffith's motion, Council Member Slusher's second by a 6-0 vote. Council Member Lewis was absent.

ADJOURNED at 11:23 a.m. on Council Member Spelman's motion, Mayor Pro Tem Goodman's second by a 6-0 vote. Council Member Lewis was absent.
