



Austin City Council MINUTES

**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - JUNE 3, 1992
TOWN LAKE CENTER - 1:30 P.M.**

Mayor Todd called to order the Special Called meeting of the Council, noting the presence of all members except Mayor Pro Tem Urdy, who arrived at 2:38 P.M. The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting was to hold a worksession on the Bond Program.

Mr. Bill Stockton, Director of Public Works and Transportation, presented his report on the City Council Bond Election to be held on August 8 of this year. He illustrated the proposed propositions for the ballot by using slides.

Mr. Stockton's presentation was followed by a question and answer period between the Council and staff members. Mayor Todd discussed when Council might expect to pass the three readings approving an Ordinance setting the ballot and calling the Bond Election.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:08 P. M., on Mayor Pro Tem Urdy's motion, Councilmember Reynolds second, 5-0 Vote, Councilmembers Epstein and Larson out of the room.
