Mayor Cooksey called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Mayor Pro Tem Trevino and Councilmember Rose.

BANNER ON CONGRESS AVENUE DENIED

The Council, on Councilmember Shipman's motion, Councilmember Carl-Mitchell's second, DENIED the request to suspend the effect of Chapter 13-13-26 of the City Code on January 7, through January 12, 1986 to allow a banner to be placed across Congress at 7th Street. (3-2 Vote, Mayor Cooksey and Councilmember Humphrey voted No.)

Staff is to find an alternate location for the banner.
