



## Austin City Council MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - JULY 29, 1993  
TOWN LAKE CENTER - 2:00 P.M.

Mayor Todd called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmembers Nofziger and Shea.

1. Presentation of City Manager's Proposed 1993-94 Operating and Capital Budget.

City Manager Camille Cates Barnett presented an overview of the budget and illustrated with charts and slides. Copies are on file in the City Clerk's office, as well as the budget documents.

Budget Director Charles Curry gave information concerning the tax roll and then Council discussed the schedule of public hearings and worksessions concerning the budget.
