**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - MAY 19, 1993  
TOWN LAKE CENTER - 3:30 P.M.**

**Mayor Todd called to order the Special Called Meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmembers Nofziger, Epstein and Mayor Pro Tem Urdy.**
