

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - MAY 3, 1993 CANVASSING - 11:00 A.M.

Waived the requirement for three readings and finally passed an ordinance ordering a runoff election to be held in the City of Austin on May 29, 1993 for the purpose of electing two Councilmembers of the City of Austin for a term of three years beginning June 15, 1993; making provision for the conduct of the election and other provisions incident to and related to the purpose thereto; vaiving the requirements of Sections 2-2-3, 2-2-5 and 2-2-7 of the Austin City Code of 1992; and declaring an Emergency. On Councilmember Larson's motion, Councilmember Garcia's second, 5-0 Vote, Mayor Pro Tem Urdy, Councilmember Epstein absent.
