



## Austin City Council MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - JULY 28, 1994  
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR - 10:00 A.M.

Mayor Todd called to order the meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmember Garcia.

### EXECUTIVE SESSION
