5. Discuss legal issues related to possible amendments to Chapter 5-7 of the Austin City Code.
6. Discuss legal issues related to professional services Procurement Act, Chapter 2254, Texas Government Code.
7. Seek legal advice regarding transfer of development rights from City owned property.
8. Discuss legal issues related to properties located within the 504.9 contour line.
9. Seek legal advice regarding School District Development Agreements.
