SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - DECEMBER 4, 1994

1. Adopt an ordinance creating a moratorium on development applications in the Barton Springs Zone and the watersheds which contribute to Barton Springs. (Councilmembers Goodman and Shea)

Ordinance 941204-A approved on Councilmember Shea's motion, Councilmember Goodman's second, 4-2 vote, Mayor Todd and Councilmember Reynolds voting No, Councilmember Mitchell absent.
