ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS UNDER CODE CHAPTER 14-8 AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF EXPENSES ON BEHALF OF THE GREATER EAST AUSTIN YOUTH ASSOCIATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE GREATER EAST AUSTIN YOUTH ASSOCIATION JUNETEENTH PARADE AND FESTIVAL TO BE HELD ON JUNE 19, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council waives the following fees and charges in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association Juneteenth Parade and Festival to be held on June 19, 2004:
