Dear Mayor Wynn and City Council Members:

The Rosewood/Glen Oaks Neighborhood Association and the Rosewood Neighborhood Planning Team supports the proposal to repair the existing bridges in the Boggy Creek Park. We also support widening the existing hike trail through the park to 10 feet (using the same gravel on the widened trail as is on the existing trail) and paving about 500 feet with a hard surface where necessary (at the bridge approaches, entrance to the park on Nile Street and Rosewood Ave, and one steep incline in the middle of the park). We thank the Mayor and City Council for your willingness to listen to our concerns and act upon them. In addition, we thank the Council for instructing staff to work with us to find an equitable compromise for all.

The replacement of the bridges will make our park safe for pedestrians and bikers. Keeping the trail surface natural will ensure that only non-vehicular traffic appropriate to our park (hikers and bikers) will be using the trail.
