ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT CAPITAL BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-02 TO CREATE A PROJECT ACCOUNT AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$93,665 in grant funds from the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for the construction of traffic signal improvements on US 183 from Pond Springs Road to RR 620.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Public Works Department Capital Budget of Ordinance No. 040913-02 to create the US 183: Pond Springs to RR 620 Signals Improvement Project account and appropriate \$93,665 to that account.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
