AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S COSPONSORSHIP OF THE "COEXISTENCE BILLBOARD ART EXHIBIT" ORGANIZED IN CONNECTION WITH THE "LIGHT - THE HOLOCAUST AND HUMANITY PROJECTTO BE EXHIBITED IN MARCH 2005; WAIVING CERTAIN FEES AND COSTS; AUTHORIZING IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council approves City co-sponsorship, including fee waivers and in-kind contributions for a total amount not to exceed $\$ 56,460$, of the "Coexistence Billboard Art Exhibit" organized in connection with "Light - The Holocaust and Humanity Project" to be exhibited in March 2005 at Auditorium Shores in the City of Austin.

PART 2. The Council waives the following fees and charges to be paid by the Austin Ballet in connection with the "Coexistence Billboard Art Exhibit."

PART 3. The Council authorizes the following in-kind contributions to the event:

PART 4. The City Manager may negotiate and execute a contract between the City of Austin and Ballet Austin for the City's co-sponsorship of the "Coexistence Billboard Art Exhibit."

PART 5. The Council finds that the need to immediately begin preparations that affect public health and safety with regard to this event constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immedia' preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
