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AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN BOARD COMPOSITION AND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 2-1 OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE BOND ELECTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- PART 1. For the following non-voting ex officio appointments to the Bond Election Advisory Committee created in Resolution No. 050217-50, the Council waives the provisions of Section 2-1-1 of the City Code requiring a member of a City board, commission, or committee to be a resident of the City:
  - (i) a member of the Austin Independent School District Board of Trustees;
  - (ii) a member of the Bastrop County Commissioners Court;
  - (iii) a member of the Caldwell County Commissioners Court;
  - (iv) a member of the Hays County Commissioners Court;
  - (v) a member of the Travis County Commissioners Court; and
  - (vi) a member of the Williamson County Commissioners Court.
- PART 2. For the Bond Election Advisory Committee, the Council waives the provisions of Section 2-1-6 of the City Code limiting the composition of a City board, commission, or committee to nine or fewer members.
- PART 3. For the Bond Election Advisory Committee, the Council waives the provisions of Section 2-1-9(A) of the City Code limiting a member of a City board, commission, or committee to serving on no more than one board at one time.
- PART 4. The Council waives the board, commission, and committee residency provisions of Section 2-1-9(A) of the City Code for the appointment of \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the Bond Election Advisory Committee.
