AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS IN CHAPTER 14-8 OF THE CODE, CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS FOR THE AUSTIN EASTSIDE STORY FOUNDATION'S 2005 PRE-JUNETEENTH PARADE AND FESTIVAL TO BE HELD JUNE 16 - 17, 2005.
