

Purchasing Service Agreement CITY OF AUSTIN RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a 12-month service agreement with NATIONAL POWER RODDING, INC. Chicago, IL, for manhole rehabilitation services for the Austin Water Utility in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,115, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,115 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$7,600,460.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$1,108,400 is included in Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility. Funding for the remaining five months of the initial contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This service agreement is necessary to support the Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP). The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order to the City of Austin in 1999, directing the elimination of sewage overflows by December 2007. Part of meeting this deadline requires the City to rehabilitate manholes throughout the City. Failure to comply with the EPA Administrative Order will result in the imposition of fines on the City of Austin and legal action taken by the EPA.

This service agreement provides for the rehabilitation of manholes throughout Austin Water Utility's service area. Manhole rehabilitation will include, when necessary, the installation of new bolted/unbolted manhole rings and covers, adjustment of existing misaligned manhole rings and covers, adjustment of grade rings of existing manholes, application of chemical grout to stop active leaks, application of pure fused calcium aluminate coatings to manhole interior walls and benches, application of epoxy coating to manhole interior walls, benches and/or inverts, repair/rebuild existing manhole benches and/or inverts, and plug abandoned sewers as directed by the City. The Contractor will make all final permanent pavement repairs around manholes and restore all sites to their original or better conditions. With little or no excavation required, street cuts and traffic disruption are minimized and wastewater service is not interrupted. This service agreement will complement the rehabilitation of small and large diameter wastewater lines utilizing the trenchless process (approved by City Council on 10/30/03).
