In 1996, the City Council passed Resolution 960425-68 directing the City Manager on certain issues related to negotiations under the "Meet and Confer" provisions of the Local Government Code. By referendum in 2004, the City adopted collective bargaining for the Austin Fire Department as a substitute for the previous "Meet and Confer" process. Because the statutory requirements of collective bargaining are fundamentally different from the "Meet and Confer" process, the proposed Resolution updates the 1996 Resolution to conform to the new bargaining environment and process. It applies only to collective bargaining negotiations with the Austin Association of Professional Fire Fighters.
