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<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize an increase in the design-build agreement for the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) Terminal Baggage Screening Improvements with HENSEL PHELPS CONSTRUCTION CO., Austin, TX, in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$21,000,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$6,500,000 is included in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of the Aviation Department. The \$21,000,000 contract is partially funded by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) via a grant and Passenger Facility Charges.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: December 11, 2003, Council approved negotiation and execution of a design-build agreement with Hensel-Phelps Construction Co. in an amount not to exceed \$14,500,000. July 17, 2003, Council approved the use and selection criteria of a Design/Build Contract as an alternative contract procurement process for the Terminal Baggage Screening Improvements at ABIA.

This project consists of Design-Build services for the design and construction of the ABIA Terminal Baggage Screening Improvements. There are currently six Explosive Detection System (EDS) machines in use on the Concourse Level at ABIA. This agreement will allow for the redesign and remodeling of the existing baggage conveyor system, to include provision for relocation and installation of existing baggage screening equipment from the Concourse Level to the Apron Level to meet requirements of the Transportation Security Administration.

This redesign is necessary to address changes requested by federal agencies and the airlines to effectively integrate the security improvements. The design-build is costing more than anticipated for two primary reasons. First, there is a nation wide effort by all airports to accomplish the same conversion of EDS units into an in-line location with existing conveyor systems. As a result, conveyor system costs have increased due to the high demand nationally. Second, there is a steel shortage caused by the rapid economic development in China. Only two of the thirteen designs have construction cost estimates below \$20 million.

Funding for the total Hensel Phelps Construction Co. contract for the ABIA Terminal Baggage Screening Improvements consists of (1) FAA grant, \$12,375,000, (2) Passenger Facility Charges, \$4,125,000 and

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(3) interim funding from the airport's Capital Fund. An amendment to the EDS Passenger Facility Charge application will be submitted to the FAA for the balance of project costs once these are finalized and the airport's Capital Fund will be reimbursed its contribution.
