<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize execution of a 12-month service agreement with ESS GROUP, DBA OHD SOUTH CENTRAL TEXAS, Brenham, TX, for maintenance and repair of overhead doors in an amount not to exceed \$151,500 with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$151,500 for each extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$454,500.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$55,834 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budget of the Fire Department and funding in the amount of \$45,161 is available in the Fiscal Year Approved Operating Budget of Austin/Travis County Emergency Medical Services. Funding for the remaining four months of the original contract period and extension option is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

**<u>PURCHASING</u>**: Lowest bid of three received.

<u>MBE / WBE:</u> This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This service agreement will provide maintenance/repair services for the overhead doors at all City of Austin Fire Department (AFD) fire stations and Austin/Travis County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) locations. The agreement will require that any maintenance/repairs performed by the service technician shall ensure that the equipment operates in an efficient and safe condition at no less than the original manufacturer's equipment specifications.

AFD estimates it will spend \$18,000 and EMS \$9,000 annually on overhead door repair parts including the ten percent discount from the vendor's catalogue price.
