SUBJECT: Approve a resolution authorizing the filing of eminent domain proceedings for the Upper Shoal Creek-Lower Hancock Branch project of the Austin Clean Water Program to acquire a permanent wastewater line easement containing 2,456 square feet and two temporary working space easements, one containing 3,500 square feet and the other containing 284 square feet, all out of Lot 2, Amended Plat of Tract A, North Loop Plaza Resubdivision #1, and Block 12 Rosedown, a subdivision in the City of Austin, and one permanent wastewater line easement containing 2,709 square feet out of Lot 16, Block 10, Rosedown, a subdivision in the City of Austin, in the amount of \$133,500. The owner of the property sought to be condemned is MWM FUND III, LTD., located in Houston, TX. The property is a located at 5218 Burnet Road, Austin, Texas.

The City of Austin is upgrading its wastewater collection system as mandated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order, received April 29, 1999, requiring the City to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows from its wastewater collection system

In response to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order, the City of Austin has assembled the Austin Clean Water Program to plan, design, and construct sustainable wastewater collection system improvements that will result in a collection system free from sanitary sewer overflows.

The design plans for the Upper Shoal Creek-Lower Hancock Branch project of the Austin Clean Water Program requires acquisition of two permanent wastewater line easements and two temporary working space easements on land located at 5218 Burnet Road, Austin, Texas.

The City of Austin has attempted to purchase the two permanent wastewater line easements and two temporary working space easements from the landowner. However, the parties have been unable to agree on an appropriate price. The Law Department is requesting authorization to file a lawsuit in eminent domain on behalf of the City of Austin.

WHEREAS, the Council finds that acquisition of the property interests described in the attachment is necessary for a public use; and


WHEREAS, the City has been unable to agree with the owner on the fair market value of the property interests to be acquired; NOW, THEREFORE,
