The project consists of the reconstruction of Pleasant Valley Road from Lakeshore Boulevard to Riverside Drive including widening for bike lanes. The section of Pleasant Valley Road from Riverside to East Oltorf will be re-striped to include bike lanes. This project will provide Austin citizens with a bicycle route from southeast Austin to other bicycle route connectors. The project includes construction of bus pads, reconstruction of driveways, re-grading of existing borrow ditches and minor water and wastewater adjustments to final pavement grades.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-ofway, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows eighty (80) working days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to eight general contractors. Bids were opened on January 13, 2005. Capital Excavation Company submitted the only responsive bid of three bids received:

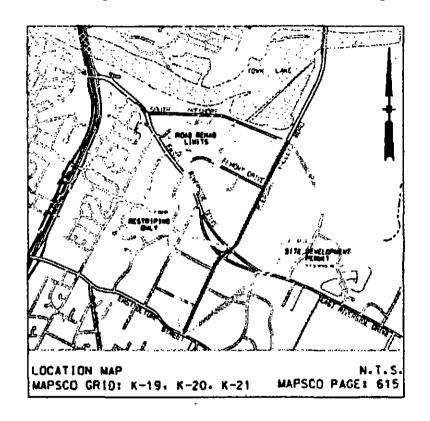
