SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a contract with MDA INSULATION, INCORPORATED, Odessa, TX, (MBE/MH-100%), for heat trace and insulation of Decker Unit 2 boiler in an amount not to exceed \$68,499.

PURCHASING: Lowest bid of two bids received.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract is for heat tracing and insulation on Decker Unit 2 boiler. Heat tracing is electrical wiring that is run along side the boiler pipes to keep them warm. Insulation and heat tracing are necessary to protect boiler drain lines from extreme freezing temperatures. If this service was not provided, the boiler would have to be drained when the unit is out of service in cold weather. The boiler holds 50,000 gallons of water with no flow, therefore, if the boiler is not protected when extreme freezing temperatures occur the pipes would freeze and could burst.
