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SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with KEYSTONE CONSTRUCTION, INC., Austin, TX for the Austin Clean Water Program's Barn Swallow Wastewater Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$584,954 plus a \$58,495.40 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$643,449.40

This construction contract will provide for wastewater collection system improvements along Pinnacle Road near Walsh Tarlton Lane. The improvements will replace deteriorated and undersized wastewater collection facilities. This project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding sanitary sewer overflows.

The proposed improvements include the installation of approximately 1,300 linear feet of 15-inch sanitary sewer along Pinnacle Road from Barn Swallow Drive to Walsh Tarlton Lane and streambank improvements within a nearby creek. Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 60 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 7 general contractors. Bids were opened on January 27, 2005. Keystone Construction, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid of 5 bids received:
