<u>SUBJECT:</u> Approve an ordinance authorizing acceptance of \$26,900 in grant funds from the Junior League of Austin; and amending the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Parks and Recreation Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 040913-1, to appropriate \$26,900 for the Naturalist Workshop Project at the Austin Nature and Science Center.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING:</u> Funding in the amount of \$26,900 is available from the Junior League of Austin. The grant period is June 15, 2005 through May 31, 2006. No City match is required.

Background

The Austin Parks and Recreation Department, Division of Natural Resources will use the grant monies to provide a Naturalist Workshop Coordinator and materials for children to learn about nature and sciences through interactive participation in a naturalist workshop.

The \$26,900 in grant funds will be used in the following way. The 20 hour per week coordinator's position (non-benefited) will be funded with \$16,000 of the grant funds. Responsibilities of the coordinator's position includes, creating ties to the natural science groups and organizations, creating the training manual, training volunteers, and filling in trader counter hours. The remaining \$10,900 of grant funds will be used to purchase trade collection, (including rocks, minerals, shells, and seeds), to purchase laboratory detection instruments (including scales, graduated cylinders tanks, pans, lapidary tools, and magnifiers), and to obtain a stereoscope. In addition this money will be used to purchase books for the resource library and to print training manuals and promotional fliers.

The naturalist workshop is an educational program designed to encourage our youth to appreciate the natural world by challenging them to learn about the biological and physical components of their environment.

One goal of this program is to further the interest and study of science (especially in children) and increase awareness of and appreciation for the natural world through an increase in participatory programs. The grant period is June 15, 2005 to May 31, 2006.

The acceptance of this grant will not require the Parks Department to increase its Operating Budget.

- 2. Strive for a 98% favorable rating for Museum Services
- 3. Naturalist workshop will engage 10% of visitors in trading, resulting in 20,000 trades
