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<u>SUBJECT</u>: Ratify a construction contract with AUSTIN FILTER SYSTEMS, INC., Austin, TX, for the Tannehill Branch at Manor Circle Emergency Contract in an amount of \$403,317.50.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Woman-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontractor opportunities were identified; therefore no goals were established for this solicitation.

The November 2004 floods and subsequent rains caused severe creek bank erosion damage along a bend of Tannehill Branch Creek adjacent to Manor Circle. On Manor Circle there are four (4) four-plex structures situated adjacent to the creek bank. The creek bank is collapsing into the creek and threatens the structural integrity of two of the four-plex structures. The foundation of one structure is undermined and exposed. If the creek bank is not stabilized as soon as possible, conditions could cause a structural failure resulting in evacuation of two four-plex structures thus displacing eight families. The Watershed Protection and Development Review Department has executed an Emergency Purchase Affidavit to repair and permanently stabilize the damaged creek bank.

Bid documents were distributed to six general contractors. Bids were opened on May 5, 2005. The Austin Filter Systems, Inc. submitted the lowest of four bids received:

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Joseph G. Pantalion who being by me first duly sworn, upon oath deposed and stated: "My name is Joseph G. Pantalion, I am over eighteen (18) years of age. I am the Director of the City of Austin Watershed Protection and Development Review Department. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth below and am competent and authorized to make this affidavit.

The November 2004 floods caused severe creek bank erosion damage along a bend of Tannehill Branch Creek adjacent to Manor Circle. On Manor Circle there are four (4) four-piex structures situated adjacent to the creek bank. The creek bank is collapsing into the creek and threatens the structural integrity of two of the four-piex structures. The foundation of one structure is undermined and exposed. If the creek bank is not stabilized as soon as possible, conditions could cause a structural failure resulting in evacuation of two four-piex structures thus displacing eight families. The Watershed Protection and Development Review Department (WPDRD) has contracted with an Engineering Design Consultant requiring the development of construction documents within 60-days. The Department of Public Works (DPW) will manage the emergency construction contract. DPW will prepare the construction contract, solicit interest from three (3) prospective contractors, and conduct a pre-bid meeting prior to the completion of the construction documents. The contractor selected will be required to start construction as soon as the emergency construction design documents are complete. WPDRD and DPW will make an effort to satisfy Minority and Women Business Enterprise participation goals.

The situation described above is a threat to public health and safety that requires the immediate appropriation of money to be resolved. I believe that future storms will further endanger both public and private amenities and necessitates immediate emergency repair. "Further Affiant sayeth not."


