Authorize a City-wide supply agreement to enable City departments to purchase shrink-wrapped computer software applications, licenses, upgrades, and software maintenance through the Department of Information Resources (DIR) Go DIRect program. Upgrades and patches provided under software maintenance programs are essential to keeping existing systems less vulnerable to virus attacks and failure. The agreement will also provide technical training and software support. 65% of the requested funds will be used for maintenance of existing software and software systems such as: AMANDA, Help Desk, GIS related systems, Oracle, the Municipal Court Case Management System, and IBM Mainframe software, and others. The remaining funds will primarily be used for new software, upgrades and licenses.

The City has been purchasing software and maintenance through DIR under an Interlocal Agreement established between the City and the State of Texas DIR that was approved by Council on December 13, 2001. The Interlocal with the State of Texas DIR specifies that the contract shall continue until terminated.

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DIR has continued to add additional products and services to its Go DIRect program at competitively bid discounted prices. Communications and Technology Management (CTM) reviews and approves technology purchases for all General Fund and Support Services Departments. When purchasing IT software through the Go DIRect Program, these departments must initiate purchase requests through CTM's "Helpdesk, IT Purchases" email address. These technology requests will undergo technology review to ensure compliance with CTM standards and technology fit with existing systems.

The supply agreement through DIR allows for the purchase of required computer software products that are installed on City-operated computers, including desktop, mobile data computers and network servers.
