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SUBJECT: Authorize negotiation and execution of a 12-month service agreement with CENTRAL PARKING SYSTEM, Austin, TX, for the management and operation of the IH-35 parking lots for the Building Services Division of the Finance and Administrative Services Department in an amount not to exceed \$72,280, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$72,280 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$216,840.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$24,093 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved IH-35 Fund of the Finance and Administrative Services Department, Building Services Division. Funding for the remaining eight months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract is for the operation and management of the two parking lots located under IH-35 between 6th and 8th Streets. The parking lots are operated as paid lots on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings, as well as for special events.


An evaluation panel consisting of personnel from Finance and Administrative Services and Neighborhood Planning and Zoning evaluated the proposals based on proposed operating plans for parking management, demonstrated applicable experience and total evaluated cost. The request for proposals was prepared with input from representatives from the IH-35 Makeover Coalition and Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT).

Property for the parking lots is leased from TxDOT and the IH-35 Makeover Coalition is comprised of property owners from surrounding areas.

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PROPOSAL ANALYSIS

a. Adequate competition.

- b. Thirty six notices were sent including two MBEs and two WBEs. Nine proposals were issued including one MBE. Five proposals were received including one MBE.
- c. The proposed fees for the operation of these lots represent an approximate 22% decrease from the previous contract fees. This can be attributed to Central Parking System's experience in operating these lots for the past two years and their awareness of the costs to operate the lots.
