The Council, on Councilmember Carl-Mitchell's motion, Councilmember Shipman's second, adopted a resolution approving Amendment No. One to the contract with Jarilyn Dupont, Attorney at Law and Annette LoVoi, Consumer Consultant, Joint Venture, for the provision of additional services as the Consumer Advocate for the Electric Utility Rate Process in an amount not to exceed \$18,480.00 and authorize the City Manager or his designee to negotiate and execute said contract amendment.
