

Austin City Council MINUTES

For AUGUST 12, 1988 - 1:00 P.M. - SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

Council Chambers, 307 West Second Street, Austin, Texas

Mayor Cooke called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Councilmember Carl-Mitchell and Mayor Pro Tem Shipman. Mayor Cooke announced the purpose of the meeting was to hold a worksession on the Proposed Operating Budget for FY 1988-89.

Four departments presented their budgets for the coming fiscal year. Hugh Standerfer and Tracy Watson reviewed the budget for <u>Planning and Development Management</u>, which included <u>Office of Land Development Services</u>, <u>Planning and Growth Management</u>, and <u>Transportation and</u> <u>Public Services Department</u>.

Austin Librach represented the <u>Environmental</u> <u>Protection Department</u>. Representatives of <u>Economic</u> <u>Development and International Trade</u> discussed their budget. Police Chief Jim Everett led the budget discussion for the <u>Police Department</u>.
