The police department requests the Council approve a resolution in support of the Austin Police Department Training Academy. In reviewing its files, Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education (TCLEOSE) decided to require all law enforcement training academies, statewide, to submit a resolution of support from the governing body of the sponsoring agency. The resolution serves the purpose of communicating to TCLEOSE that the law enforcement academy is needed by the City of Austin.

The Austin Police Department Training Academy provides the training required for all new police officers of the City of Austin in addition to ongoing and specialized training for sworn officers. The Austin Police Department Training Academy is licensed by TCLEOSE, and has been licensed by the State of Texas since August 22, 1968. The Austin Police Department, including its Training Academy, has been inspected and formally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc.(CALEA).

WHEREAS, the City Council is aware that the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education (TCLEOSE) requires that every existing or proposed law enforcement training academy submit a resolution of support from the governing body of the sponsoring organization; and

WHEREAS, the Austin Police Department Training Academy provides the training required for all new police officers of the City of Austin in addition to ongoing and specialized training for sworn officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that the Austin Police Department Training Academy is licensed by TCLEOSE, and has been licensed by the State of Texas since August 22, 1968; and that the Austin Police Department, including its Training Academy, has been inspected and formally accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., (CALEA); NOW, THEREFORE,

The City Council acknowledges its continued support for the Austin Police Department Training Academy as a necessary component of the Austin Police Department.
