SUBJECT: Set a public hearing on the Central Austin Combined Neighborhood Plan, an element of the Austin Tomorrow Comprehensive Plan, including the Hancock, North University, and West University Neighborhood Planning Areas. The combined planning area boundaries are: Lamar Blvd and Duval St. to the west, 38th St. and 45th St. to the north, IH-35 to the east, and MLK Jr. Blvd. to the south, excluding the University of Texas at Austin campus. (Recommended date and time for the public hearing: May 6, 2004, 4:00 PM, Lower Colorado River Authority, Hancock Building.)
