PURCHASING: Lowest bid of ten received.

MBE / WBE: Participation subgoals stated in the solicitation were 22.96% MBE and 5.42% WBE.

The Walnut Creek – Wells Branch Flood/Erosion Control Regional Pond project is located in the far northeast quadrant of the City in the vicinity of West Parmer Lane at North Lamar Boulevard. The project consists of a concrete dam upstream of West Parmer Lane within the Wells Branch Tributary of Walnut Creek (202.9 acre-feet) and associated wastewater line relocation. The project will also include the construction of a floodwall adjacent to a commercial tract in accordance with the Walnut Creek/Parmer Planned Unit Development (PUD) agreement. The project will mitigate erosion near 33 homes and mitigate the flood hazard to 7 at-risk houses in the ultimate 100-year floodplain downstream of the W. Parmer Lane Bridge.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and to provide for the expeditious processing of change orders 5% contingency has been included.


The contract allows 270 calendar days for completion of this project.
